FROM CONFLICT TO COMMUNION

Join Bishop Patrick Dunn and Assistant Bishop of the Lutheran Church in NZ, Rev. Jim Pietsch at the Lutheran-Catholic Common Commemoration on the 500th Anniversary of the Reformation, Tuesday 31 October at 7.30pm at St Patrick's Cathedral, Wyndham St, Auckland.

The reformation was a time of conflict and challenge. 500 years on there is still healing and hurt between Christians and it is good for Catholics to acknowledge this anniversary and revisit some of the history.
