The prophet ISAIAH 6:1-8

Isaiah, a royal advisor

'sees' God's holiness .. and responds to God's call



PSALM 137

I thank you, Lord, with all my heart,
you have heard the words of my mouth.
In the presence of angels I will bless you
I will adore before your holy temple.

I thank you for your faithfulness and love
which excel all we ever knew of you.
On the day I called, you answered;
You increased the strength of my soul.

All the rulers of earth shall thank you
when they hear the words of your mouth.
They shall sing of the Lord's ways:
How great is the glory of the Lord!

You stretch out your hand and save me,
your hand will do all things for me.
Your love, O Lord, is eternal,
discard not the work of your hands.

1st letter to the Corinthians 15:1-11

St Paul has 'seen' Christ risen!
he hands on this to new believers

LUKE 5:1-11

Peter's 'unworthiness' as Jesus
calls him to 'catch'
men, women, children ..

FUEL FOR THE FIRE OF LOVE
Peter was so aware of his failings
but from this call, things
were to be different.

The Jesus looking at Peter
is the Saviour of the world
.. here to call sinners.

Peter in recognising Jesus is
acutely aware of his sinfulness
- as was Isaiah in his vision of God.

Every believer is called to this experience.

What do we know of this Jesus?
Is he a catechism formula?
A name? An image?

Jesus' real presence to us
reveals our sinfulness
as it reveals his forgiveness.

He makes our sin bearable
and like Peter
it becomes fuel
for the fire of love.
