**LITURGICAL ARRANGEMENTS EMERGING FROM COVID**

Priests of North Shore met this week and proposed the following recommendations for our parishes, as covid government restrictions are eased. Our parish council has agreed to these recommendations:

1. Hand sanitiser - continue providing it at church entrances, and for Ministers of Holy Communion
2. Psalm books (weekday Masses) - reintroduce according to parish practice
3. Masks - Optional use - Ministers to wear masks while ministering Communion only
4. Holy Water - return to holy water in fonts immediately
5. Sign of Peace - Continue bowing for the present
6. Communion on the tongue is discouraged
7. Communion from the chalice - delay re-introducing the cup until we are more sure of the health situation
