### Unborn Remembrance Day

Join us at 1pm next Saturday 29 October as we gather to mark New Zealand's hidden death toll at the annual Unborn Remembrance Day. 17 peaceful vigils will be held outside abortion facilities, in unison, all around NZ as a witness to the tragic loss of thousands of lives that were aborted in 2021. This might be the last time we can legally gather outside of the facilities where our Nation's sons and daughters have their lives violently ended. NZ abortion facilities can now apply for a 150m exclusion zone, meaning that peaceful pro-life vigils within that zone will be considered a criminal act in NZ. We must stand while we still can!
