### GOSPEL - LUKE 20:27-38

Jesus 'out-wits' an absurd 'Sadducee'  
question - He affirms our (and His)  
future resurrection to life

### THE SADDUCEES INSINCERE QUESTION

Jesus turns an insincere question  
to an opportunity for genuine teaching.

'Our resurrection from the dead'.

'Sadducees' were priestly temple rulers  
they did not hold with bodily resurrection  
- a 'late' and 'new' idea in Jewish thought.

A childless widow could re-marry  
within her dead husband's family  
to raise up children for the clan.

The Sadducees push their question to absurdity  
to make Jesus look ridiculous  
'at the resurrection, to which of  
7 brothers will she be wife?'

Jesus reminds them .. God revealed Himself  
to Moses as 'God of Abraham, of Isaac,  
of Jacob' long dead in time .. but alive in God!

Covenant relationship is an alive reality  
and continuing promise  
which death cannot destroy.

Jesus himself will soon enough  
have to depend on his Father's promise.

(After the Jerusalem Temple is destroyed  
A.D. 70 the 'Sadducees' ceased to exist)
