Mark wrote his gospel, 60 A.D. for persecuted Christians in Rome - being thrown to wild beasts in the arena.

Jesus, newly baptised prepares for his public ministry surrounded by 'Satan' and the wild beasts.

Christ's followers are heartened in their persecutions, trials and sufferings to know that Jesus faced all this.

His baptism 'You are my beloved Son' was his strength and 'ministering angels' to defeat Satan - God's adversary.

Our life-time calling, like Jesus is to hear God the Father's voice - we are God's beloved through our own baptism.

'Lent' calls us to face the enemy within us.

Mark's good news is that we do this with Jesus and in solidarity with all who follow Him.
