De Paul House needs your help

De Paul House supports families and senior citizens needing housing, advocacy and help to address significant material hardship. We have 45 transitional houses and 11 social houses, that offer long term affordable housing.

We also provide help to those struggling to sustain tenancies in the community, especially senior citizens. Over the past 3 weeks, in partnership with Kainga Ora over 20 families have moved mostly into the new builds. From our donated goods banks we support families with the basics to set up home.
