my cup is more than full.

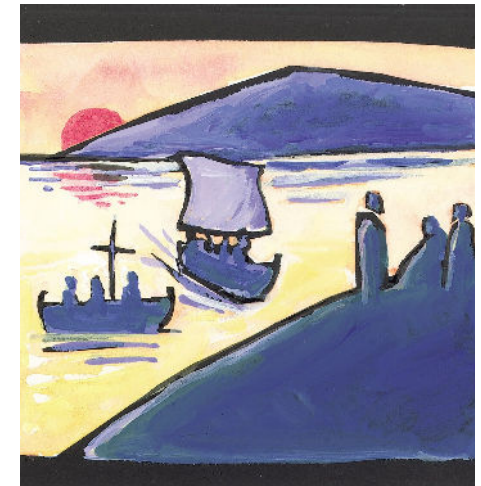
Goodness and love will tend me
