


DEAR PARISHIONERS OF ST JOSEPH's, after 5 days of rest following the Camino, Mary-Anne McKay and I flew south to Seville to spend about ten days in the southern part of Spain. Our post-Camino travels remind me of Pope Francis' theme for the holy year which begins on Christmas Eve: Pilgrims of Hope. Hope is about experiencing our own limitations and trusting that the Lord will bring about what truly is for our best. Both of us put money on Cash Passports to pay our way - but their system crashed 10 days ago. We would have been stranded if I hadn't also had a Wise card, which is excellent and dependable. We've tried to book rail travel online unsuccessfully: we went to a railway station seeking help and discovered we could travel more cheaply by buying an inexpensive senior's card. The Lord provides for us! We'll continue travelling in hope, trusting that the Lord has a better way for us than our limited planning! You are in my prayers.
